
BE PART OF THE FUTURE ARTS CENTRE

The school of fish community campaign aims to engage 75 people to celebrate the past and future of the Elora Centre for the Arts. It celebrates 75 Melville Street, the location of the former 1800's schoolhouse, now the Arts Centre. Each donor purchases a fish, ultimately creating a 75-fish sculpture on permanent display in the yard at the Elora Centre for the Arts.

All proceeds will to towards the Arts Centre's new addition.

CREATIVITY LIVES HERE

Designed by local metal artist Mike Hintermeister, this sculpture recognizes the immense importance of the Grand River and the historic significance of the Arts Centre. The school of 75 fish within this vibrant and "alive" sculpture acknowledges the 75 community members who contribute to the future expansion project of the Arts Centre. Made of alumnimum, the fish are swimming upstream toward the Grand River. Fish spawn upstream to provide the place to lay and hatch their eggs so that the following cohort can prosper. The Elora Centre for the Arts was the original school serving the area and this idea of nurturing and encouraging a legacy is aptly represented in this scultpure. The school of fish will be installed along the sloped roof of the new outdoor performance pavilion.

The underlying message of this piece will speak to the importance of working together as a group to achieve a goal, the flow of life and our collective passion to move forward together.
